To this end she completed a master's in this field at the University of Zaragoza. Since 2019 she has a website – "Telar de Libros" – that promotes reading. Nick and Arthur's Alphabet is her first published book.

Illustrator

Roger Olmos (Barcelona, 1975) studied children's illustration at the Llotja de Barcelona School of Applied Arts. In 1999 he was shortlisted at the Bolonia Fair and Kalandraka published his first book, A Wolf's Tale. His method consists of focusing in on life's details to get and keep the reader's attention, while leaving room for interpretation. He has close ties with Italy, where Logos Edizioni regularly publish his books. He has also worked for Edelvives, Random House Mondadori, Macmillan, Kalandraka, Ediciones B, La Galera, Bromera... and now, with this book, for A Fin de Cuentos. His work has been awarded numerous prizes.
